U.S.S MIAMI SSN-775

USS Miami, a Los Angeles Class nuclear attack sub was dry docked at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard for its 20 month maintenance cycle. On May 23, 2012 at 1737 hours an alarm was received at PSNY Fire Headquarters. Thanks to members William 'Skip' Sullivan and Chris Silver for the information.

Wednesday May 23rd, 2012

1737 hours First alarm for fire onboard the USS Miami (SSN-755)
PNSY FD; 3 engines; 1 truck; 1 heavy rescue; 1 ambulance responding

1744 hours Kittery FD 1 engine for station coverage at PNSY FD

1840 hours Kittery Engine 1 to the fire scene

1945 hours Portsmouth Engine 1 and Ambulance 1 to the scene

2100 hours* Assistance requested from Sub Base Groton CT; South Portland FD
Pease ANG Base (foam); Hanscom AFB (foam); Logan Airport (foam)

2106 hours Rye E-3; Newington E-3; New Castle E-4 & Hose 1 dispatched to the fire

2128 HOURS Greenland E-2 to Portsmouth for station coverage

2132 hours Rye Chief 1 reports by cell phone to Rockingham County fire dispatch
"Nuclear portion of boat is **not** involved. Crews being rotated and making
Progress".

2137 hours Mutual Aid District SCBA support unit from Rye responding to the fire

2213 hours Mutual Aid District SCBA support unit from Lee responding to the fire

2246 hours Rye Chief 1 reports by cell phone to Rockingham County fire dispatch
"Fire is contained to the bow section of the boat. Extensive overhaul
Required. Rye firefighter collapsed in the boat. Transported to
Portsmouth Regional."
